Spring Conference Items of Interest

CRNA Panel for RNs - Saturday April 11, 2026, from 2 p.m. - 4 p.m.

This session is for Registered Nurses interested in a career as a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA).

The first hour is intended to provide an overview of what a CRNA does. It will include a brief presentation on the history of CRNAs, their current practice, and job opportunities followed by a presentation from a panel comprised of CRNAs with a variety of backgrounds. The CRNA panelists will answer questions for approximately 30 minutes with time for questions and answers following.

The second hour will cover the educational requirements to become a CRNA. It will include a panel of program faculty members and current SRNAs. Faculty will detail the educational and clinical experience requirements, application process, and rigors of attending a program. SRNAs on the panel will share their backgrounds, how they became interested in becoming a CRNA and their experiences in the program, following by questions and answers from attendees.
